#### Attention ALL RWU STUDENTS!

RWU RECYCLES! Recycling at Roger Williams has just become easier than ever before!

Effective Immediately, <u>Single Stream Recycling</u> is in effect at Roger Williams University

#### What does this mean?

<u>All</u> campus recycling bins can now be used for <u>all</u> recyclables (no cardboard).

If an item doesn't fit through the hole on top, just <u>lift the lid!</u>







## Use <u>ALL</u> of these for <u>ALL RECYCLABLES</u> – except cardboard!

#### NO Cardboard in the Trash or Recycling Bins!

Just put all cardboard next to the recycling bin like this:



#### WHAT CAN YOU RECYCLE?

- clean and dry paper
- junk mail
- cans (empty)
- glass bottles and jars (empty)
- plastic milk and soda bottles (empty)
- plastic containers (empty up to 5 gallons example: laundry detergent bottle)
- phonebooks,
- metal lids
- foil
- plastic take-out containers (RINSED)

Again, if the item that you're trying to recycle won't fit through the hole on top of the container, please just lift the lid, put the item in and replace the lid.

The only recyclable that should <u>NOT</u> go into the recycling bins is large pieces of cardboard.

Please place cardboard next to the trash can or recycling bin.

# What goes into wastebaskets and trash cans now (what CANNOT be recycled)???

- used tissues and paper towels,
- food scraps,
- paper that is coated to be waterproof,
- food wrappers,
- greasy pizza boxes,
- plastic bags (or please take them to the grocery store for re-use),
- non-container plastics and Styrofoam (plastic folders, plastic eating utensils),
- containers that are plastic-foil hybrids (juice pouches)
