

## Academic advising for Transfer Students

As a transfer student, your first semester advising is important for several reasons. It is important to establish a good relationship with your faculty advisor. Please refer to our "Tips for establishing a successful advising relationship". You must also confirm that all your transcripts have been submitted to the Office of the Registrar, and evaluated for transfer credit. If you have questions about transfer credits, please contact the Registrar and your Faculty Advisor. To advise you correctly, your Faculty Advisor must have a complete transfer credit evaluation in your advising file.

The Advising Center can provide support and advising to transfer students. We are located next to the Registrar. If you have difficulty understanding the process of transfer evaluations, one of our advisors is available to work with you and your faculty advisor to ensure that your credits are correctly evaluated and transferred. Additionally, if you conclude that you want to change your major, the advisors in the Advising Center are here to guide you through that decision making process.
