**For inclement weather situations, a single operating status is determined for entire university including:**

- Bristol Campus
- Providence Campus
- Law School

**Here are the possible operating status levels:**

- University operating under normal conditions.
- All university operations canceled: essential services personnel only
- Classes canceled; other operations open as usual.
- Day classes canceled; evening classes as usual.
- Day classes only; all evening classes canceled.
- Delayed opening; all operations to begin after specific time; essential services personnel to report as usual.

**VP/CIO** informs **Communications Team, Senior Management Team** of operating status decision.

**4**

**Provost** informs **Academic Leadership Team**.

**5<sub>a</sub>**

**Communications Team** alerts campus community via appropriate channels.

**5<sub>b</sub>**

**Academic Leadership** and **Senior Management** teams alert managers, staff as necessary.
