

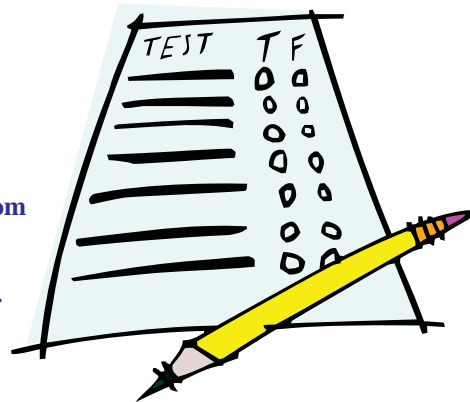
Fall 2009 Final Exam Schedule
