

EDU 211L/212L and NATSC 211/212 – Teaching and Learning Science through Inquiry

Prerequisites: EDU 200 and EDU 202

Must be taken concurrently with or after Edu 302.

The goal of this two-semester course (offered in conjunction with NATSC 211/212) is to integrate a broad base of science knowledge with the positive attitudes and skills needed for teaching science successfully in the elementary school. Coursework focuses on inquiry-based learning through active participation in environmental research focused on Mt. Hope Bay. This course is available only to elementary education majors and satisfies both the Core Science (CORE 101) and Science Education (EDU 341) requirements. *(2 credits per course). 211 offered in Fall, 212 offered in Spring.*
