

EDU 505 – Technology Applications in the Classroom

This course is required for all students in the MAT and Masters of Literacy programs. EDU 505 addresses all of the National Education Technology Standards for Teachers (NETS-T). The course covers technology integration and assessment strategies, legal and ethical issues in technology, assistive technology, technology planning and funding, as well as the use of a wide variety of hardware and software applications. Students who feel competent using technology productivity tools (such as word processing, e-mail, and Internet search engines) and have experience with the Windows Operating System (making folders, saving and naming files, printer options, etc.) have the appropriate background to take this course during the summer session. Students who feel that their skills are outdated, or who have little technology background, will find that taking the course during the 14-week term in the fall or spring will better serve their needs.
