

EDU 601 – Graduate Practicum in Elementary Education

Prerequisite: Completion of Course Work

This course is designed to prepare pre-service teachers for student teaching. Students are usually placed in a Rhode Island public school for a minimum of 100 hours of participation. During this field experience, students are required to perform several teaching actions and provide corresponding artifacts in their Performance in the Classroom portfolio. This is a supervised field experience. University supervisors visit participants in their school settings, score their performance artifacts, and provide seminars to debrief experiences.
