Or, accordingly has a least a 24 composite score on the ACT.

The scholarship is awarded on the basis of academic and extracurricular achievements. To renew the scholarship for four years, the candidate must maintain a minimum Roger Williams University GPA of 3.0 and commit five hours of community service to the Portsmouth (RI) School District.
