PROCEDURE RELATING TO EPINEPHRINE

Pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws Section 16-78-1, which addresses the use of Epinephrine, Roger Williams University (“University”) hereby adopts the following procedure:

1. For University students who receive services through University Health Service:
 - All students who indicate an allergy requiring the use of Epinephrine on their health history will be sent a letter requesting they come into Health Service.
 - Health Service will verify the need and recommendation for Epinephrine.
 - The student will be given a prescription for Epinephrine if they do not have one and instructed on treatment and prevention while on campus.

2. The University shall periodically notify the University community of the location of Epinephrine on the University’s campus. Such may include an annual announcement and/or the posting of such listing on University department webpages.

3. The University maintains Epinephrine in the following locations:
 - University Health Service
 - Public Safety Emergency Medical Technician vehicles

4. Department of Public Safety Emergency Medical Technicians and University Health Service employees are trained in the proper administration of Epinephrine and may administer Epinephrine in the event of an emergency.
