ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Students interested in the M.B.A. program should be current RWU students or recent alumni with a major or minor in the Mario J. Gabelli School of Business. Students with undergraduate business degrees from other accredited institutions may be considered.

To apply, applicants must submit the following items to the Office of Graduate Admission:

- Completed application form. An application fee is not required for RWU students. Please use the fee waiver code GRCRWU.
- Letter of Intent (no more than two double-spaced pages) describing your interest in the M.B.A. program, career goals, and how you can positively contribute to the program.
- 3. Two (2) letters of recommendation attesting to your potential to succeed in graduate school.
- 4. Official college transcripts from all colleges or universities attended, which should be submitted directly from the issuing institution to the Office of Graduate Admission. For current RWU students, transcripts will be obtained on your behalf.
- If your first language is not English, an official report of TOEFL or IELTS results.

It is recommended that students present at least a 3.0 cumulative undergraduate GPA in order to be considered for admission to the M.B.A. program. Students may be asked to take the GMAT or GRE in order to strengthen their case for admission. Beta Gamma Sigma members will receive automatic waivers of standardized testing requirements. The ETS School Code for Roger Williams University is 3729. Each application will be reviewed using a portfolio approach all parts of the application will be considered inclusive of grades and trend of grades, letters of recommendation, the letter of intent, and other information that candidates for admission may wish to submit.
