I. Committee Business

Chair reminded the Committee that two seats will be vacant at the completion of this semester as Kate Mele and Judy Platania terms will be completed. Elections will be held in late spring to fill these seats.

Curricunet Issues

Chair stated that Curricunet now indicates P/No Pass option in Grading section of petition. In addition, there is an option for Student Choice. Question regarding the disappearance of the P/F option and the implications for the removal of this choice. The Committee asked how these features are altered. CM offered to contact the Registrar to determine and will apprise the Committee when the information is available.

Honors 101 petition has been removed (withdrawn) – a new one will be generated that will go through Robert Shea, who will also have an account to review petitions. All Honors course will be vetted through Associate Provost Shea.

Committee discussed the possibility of Curricunet including a feature that alerts Committee's awareness to petitions in review at the Dean level. In this way we will be better able to gauge the extent of the upcoming review at the CAS CC level.

- Consider all discrepancies identified in Minutes of December 9 and address the specific issues mentioned.

Direct the petitioner to include language that is specific to RI licensure. Also review all minor tabs to ensure they correctly identify the course.
