Corporate Communication Certificate Modification

Adding IDS 400: Professional Ethics (1 credit)

- ✓ This course would be self-paced through bridges.
- ✓ This course would be specific ethical issues and concepts from the specific discipline—therefore there would be different “courses” for the different certificates/programs albeit in one Bridges IDS course.
- ✓ Students would enroll in the IDS 105 course, and the “instructor” (probably me) would put the student in the correct bridges group based on their certificate/program

Each Certificate’s ethic module would consist of a series of readings that end in the student answering multiple choice/true false and or matching questions. These quizzes would be graded in the bridge system. As long as the student scores a certain percentage the student would move on to the next reading/questions section. At the conclusion of the readings & quizzes, the student will receive a certification of completion, that they would need to print out and provide the program director to receive a Pass on their transcript.
