Management is the study of how to understand and motivate people within organizations both large and small. RWU students in management explore leadership, influence, and organizational behavior, among other topics. A degree in management is also valuable to aspiring entrepreneurs.

## STUDENT EXPERIENCE

### Learn and Do More at RWU

With a focus on experiential learning at RWU, management majors can:

- Examine case studies such as: the way Disney Animation Studios handles organizational change, JetBlue's employee training development program, and Fresh To Table's exploration of the impact of social media on workplace culture.
- Gain real-world experience through partnerships with community organizations and working on the issues that are important to them. For example, RWU students have produced an in-depth analysis on local business entities for the Rhode Island Secretary of State's office, revamped human resources procedures and policies for a local museum, and produced a major systems planning report for a local health care organization.
- Develop skills in building effective teams; learn communication and public speaking through group projects and internships; and develop conflict resolution and negotiation ability through role playing.
