FINANCIAL AID/SCHOLARSHIPS

Students in the School of Continuing Studies are eligible for all of the traditional forms of financial aid that are normally associated with adult and continuing education students. In addition, our Advisory Board for Continuing Education makes several scholarships available each academic year to eligible students enrolled in the School of Continuing Studies, based on a combination of financial need, academic promise, prior academic experience and/or community service. ENROLLMENT

In order to enroll in the School of Continuing Studies, you must complete the following steps:

1. Complete an Application for Admission
2. Submit Application for Admission to the School of Continuing Studies with a \$50 application fee
3. Submit an official high school transcript or grade results of G. E. D.
4. Submit official transcripts of prior college attendance (if applicable)
5. Submit official documentation of military training and experience (if applicable)
6. Submit official documentation of CLEP and/or DANTES exam results (if applicable)
