Vote in Person at Home

1. Confirm that you are registered to vote at home by contacting your town hall.
2. Ask if they offer early voting options that work with your class schedule.
3. You may have to quarantine depending on what state you visit. Check this information before travelling.

Advantages

Impact local and statewide races that affect your home and community.

Vote in Bristol for the Full Ballot, Live on Main Campus

1. Register as a RI resident by 10/4.
 - a. If you have a RI driver's license, register online at vote.SOS.ri.gov
 - b. If not, download the voter registration form at vote.SOS.ri.gov
2. Polling location is Guiteras Elementary School in Bristol, accessible by RIPTA and campus shuttle.
3. Early voting begins 10/14 at Town Hall (10 Court Street), Monday through Friday, 8am – 4pm.

Advantages

Early voting. Impact Bristol and statewide races. Convenient!

Live Off Campus?

Register to vote using the address where you live this semester. This will determine your polling location.

Live at Almeida? Your address is 201 Bayview Ave, Bristol, RI 02809.

Live at Baypoint? Your address is 144 Anthony Road, Portsmouth, RI 02871.

Vote by Absentee Ballot

1. Start NOW!
2. Absentee ballots must be requested from your town hall or Secretary of State in advance.
3. They also have deadlines (vary by state) so read all absentee information carefully!

Advantages

Impact local and statewide races in your home community. No travel involved!

Vote in Bristol for President and VP Only

BUT you can register to vote in RI and cast your vote on Election Day:

- Only at Town Hall (10 Court Street)
- Only for Pres/VP
- BRING YOUR PHOTO ID (RWU ID is acceptable)
