<u>Definition:</u> Batteries are classified as Universal Waste by the RI department of Environmental Management. Different kinds of batteries contain different chemicals,including potassium hydroxide, sulfuric acid, lead, nickel, cadmium, and silver. DO NOT THROW AWAY.

Common Battery Types: Alkaline (AA, AAA, C, D, 9 Volt, etc.), Lithium, Nickel-Cadmium, Lead-acid, Silver-oxide, and, Nickel-metal hydride.
