The Jewish High Holidays of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur will be observed in synagogues throughout Rhode Island during the next two weeks:

Rosh Hashanah (Jewish New Year): Wednesday evening, September 24, through Friday, September 26

Yom Kippur (Day of Atonement): Friday evening, October 3, through Saturday, October 4
